

Evaluation of Sports Premium Fund Spending 2017-2018

Over the past academic year £12,540 was spent on CPD for staff, £620 was spent on mini bus hire to improve attendance in level 2 competitions, £127 spent on HSSA affiliation fee which has enabled us to take part in athletics, football league competition and the dance festival and £43 was spent on the hire of facilities for Level 2 tournaments. £1031 was spent on balance bikes for EYFS and KS1 and £3937 was spent on outdoor gym equipment.

To improve the range of sports and opportunities for children to enjoy them competitively.	All staff have received CPD in an area which was unknown to them before e.g. Circuit training. As a result of feedback given from staff after these sessions a range of equipment has been bought to implement these sports into our yearly cycle.	To develop a range of ways to deliver a skill. To increase the number of level 1 competitions. To have an A and B team for one sport.
To ensure that all children are active for 60 minutes a day.	We have installed the Golden Mile and are ready to launch in Healthy Living week in the new year. Three pieces of outdoor gym equipment was ordered and installed over the Summer holidays. 10 balance bikes were ordered and assembled over the school holidays ready to launch in September. Heat mapping has been compiled for a 'typical KS2 class and steps have been put in place to boost activity from September. Children have access to a wider range of clubs and activities on the playground. Lunchtime clubs provided by BeeActive which access all children from reception to Y6 are popular and keep children engaged and actives during lunchtime.	To develop children's awareness of personal best. To develop children core strength and physical fitness.
To implement an assessment system for PE.	All staff received training on honeycomb. All staff reported that they were more confident assessing children and moving them forward/supporting their development. However they found the app system time consuming as a result BeeActive and the PE lead are taking on board their feedback and looking for a more succinct way of collating the data.	To continue to develop an effective assessment system for PE. To increase the number of children swimming 25m.
