**Aromatherapy** - We are very fortunate to have a close link with a qualified aromatherapist who leads our Aromatherapy club. Children make a range of treats including: body wash; aroma bags; cherry bakewell pie soap; winter lip balms; bath oils using essential oils and rainbow bath salts.

**Science CREST Award** - Children undertake eight hours of science investigative study to achieve their SuperStar badge and certificate. The CREST Science Awards scheme is the British Science Association's flagship programme for young people and is the only nationally recognised accreditation scheme for STEM project work (science, technology, engineering and mathematics).
