A gentle reminder! The school day starts at **8.40 am**, please ensure your child/ren is here on time.

If a child is late

5 minutes every day this equates to 3.5 days absence over the year

10 minutes late every day - 7 days over the year

15 minutes late every day - 10 days over the year

20 minute late every day - 14.5 days over the year

30 minutes late every day - 22 days over the year.

In some areas parents can be fined if their child is persistently late for school, late arrivals **are recorded** in the register. Children arriving late miss important messages and teaching points and late arrivers disrupt the other children's learning. We all know that occasionally plans go awry in the mornings but these should be very isolated events. Lets work together to make sure all the children are in school on time every day.



With the weather changing, could you please ensure that your child has a pair of wellies and a coat in school every day.
