How to support your child

- A general discussion on what they have been learning in school.
- Encouraging children to become independent learners e.g homework.

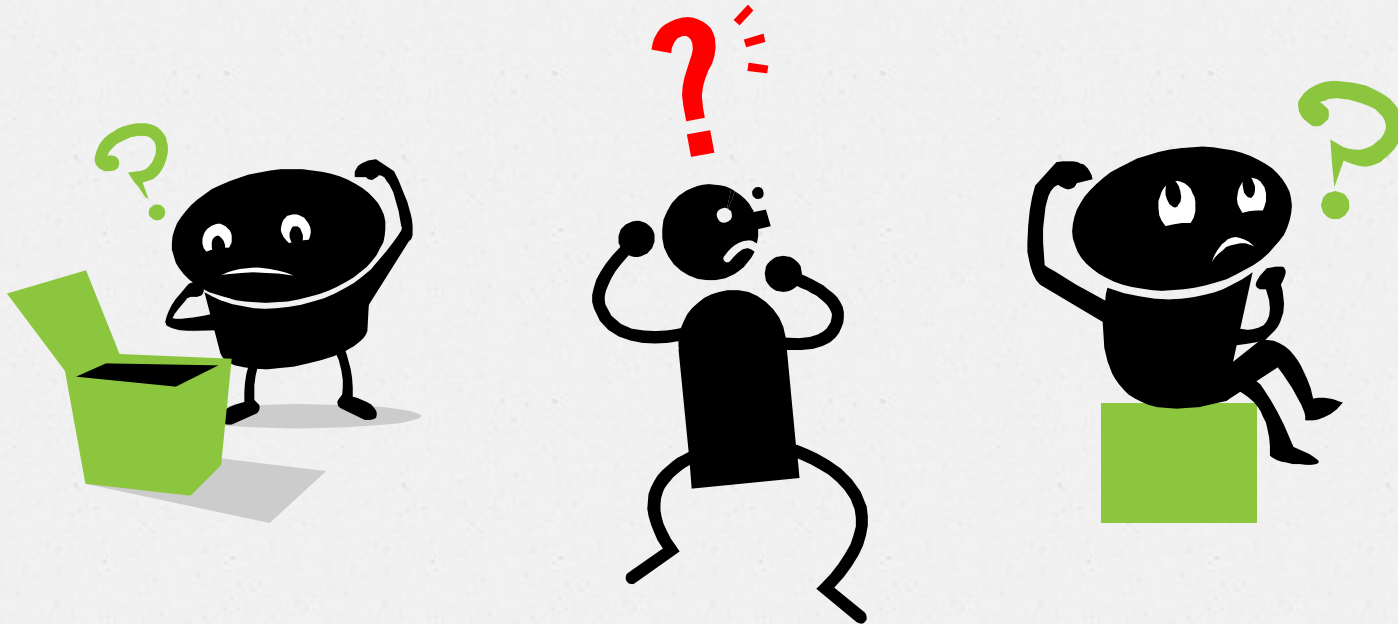
