

## Maths homework

Maths homework will normally be set on mymaths: <https://www.mymaths.co.uk/>

Mymaths homework is good because it gives students instant feedback on the subject they are doing, and they can see all their assignments and scores for the year. Mymaths also explains how to do the work, so if you are stuck you can get help!

Parents: you can see your child's homework scores! Ask them to click on the 'my results' tab.

Usually homework will be set on the topic they have been doing in class. Sometimes it will be revision. Sometimes it will new topic for them to try.

It will be set on Friday, to be completed by the following Friday.

If your child doesn't complete the homework, they will be warned to hand it in next lesson. If it's not handed in next lesson, parents will be informed by email. The teacher might set a detention after school if the student is falling behind, giving them the opportunity to catch up.

The homework can be attempted as many times as the student needs. The best score is recorded.

We expect students to get green! (70% or more) If it's amber or red, the student is expected to improve this.

We run a maths homework club every Monday from 3.10 – 4.10, in room I1. A maths teacher is always on hand to support students.
