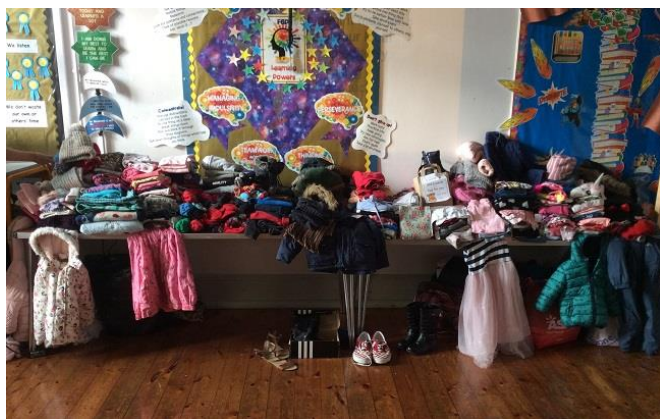
Harvest Festival
