Dear Parents/Carers,

It was really nice to see so many parents this week at Parents' Evening. We hope that the revised format was helpful and that it was more consistent throughout the school. I will be reading through the evaluations and giving feedback to the Parent Focus Group and the wider parent body in time.

We have had much excitement at the KS1 site this week with the installation of our new play trail. This is the start of a project to improve the site including our new annexe which will be starting to take shape at half-term. The children have absolutely loved watching the builders at work and their new trail emerging from the ground – they can't wait to play on it. We have used the money from our Sport's Premium Grant to fund this project and alongside the support of the PTA we have plans to make sure the KS1 site continues to improve.

We have had a number of children out and about visiting some of our local schools this week. A small group of children visited Downton Primary School and listened to the author Andy Griffiths who writes the '13<sup>th</sup> Storey Treehouse' series of books. He told us all about his inspiration behind his book and how he used his imagination to write and engage the children in reading. We also had a number of children from year 6 visit Alderbury and West Grimsted School for an Art day. They had a really inspiring day and they will be sharing some of their experience with us ready for next week's newsletter.

As a school we are very reliant on our Admin team for ensuring the smooth running of the school. Unfortunately, things do go wrong and we are very sorry over the mix up of photographs last week. We have a new date in place to ensure all siblings have their photographs taken on the 23rd October. We would be very grateful if parents could help the admin team return paperwork to the school within the deadline date. Currently we get about a 70% return and the team then spend a large amount of time chasing paperwork. Your co-operation with this matter would mean that they can use their time more efficiently.

As part of our on-going safeguarding awareness I am growing more concerned about the access children in the school are having to social media. I will be sending a letter home next week about the concerns over certain sites and how parents can ensure their children are using social media correctly. In particular, the game Fortnite is a major concern because of the nature of the game. 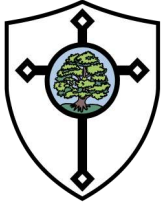
