

SPORT PREMIUM – 2018-19 Funding to support Primary PE and School Sport

Background

In September 2017, the Government announced significant, new increased funding for all schools for physical education (PE) and sport. It is crucial that as a school, we invest this money wisely in order to cover the following areas:

- Engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – 30 mins per day
 - Increase confidence, knowledge and skill of all staff in teaching PE and sport
 - Broaden the experience of a range of sports and outdoor activities offered to all pupils
 - Increase participation in competitive sport
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- Hatherley Infant School will receive **£17070**
 - Alongside Maths and English, Sports Premium will be the third area to be inspected by Ofsted therefore it is vitally important that we utilise the funding effectively.

Hatherley Infant School plan

- We are planning to invest this additional funding into increasing outdoor physical activity and experiences for all pupils. In order to do this we are developing our 'natural area' into a Forest School area. During the first part of this year the area will be developed and two members of staff will be trained as Forest School Teachers and then at the start of the Spring term all children will begin to benefit from the use of this area. Children will be able to work as a team, problem solve and gain key skills through a range of outdoor activities such as den building, outdoor crafting and fire making.
- We have several new members of staff at Hatherley Infant School and some of our funding will ensure that all teaching staff are appropriately trained in order to feel confident in delivering high quality PE lessons to all children in all aspects of our PE curriculum.
- We are ensuring that we provide all children with a minimum of 30 minutes physical activity per day by developing wake and shake sessions, launching 'The Daily Mile' during 'lulls' in learning time and providing a range of after school free activities including Football and Zumba. Vulnerable groups will also be targeted; where we will provide sustainable opportunities for children to make healthy lifestyle choices. This will take place through a lunch time 'funky fitness' club as well as an after school 'healthy lifestyles' club; where children will prepare a healthy meal for their tea as well as learn the importance of keeping active.
- We are ensuring that every child takes part in at least one inter-school sporting event; whether it be competitive or non-competitive throughout the course of the year. Training sessions will be given where relevant and transportation provided for children to attend competitions and events such as cross country, bean bag rounders, bench ball, gymnastics and sports festivals
