Fenton Fest 2019 – Sunday 26 May

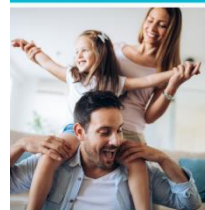
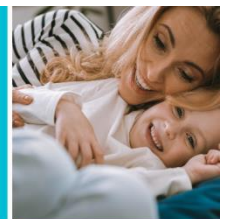
