New Morning Drop-off Routine:

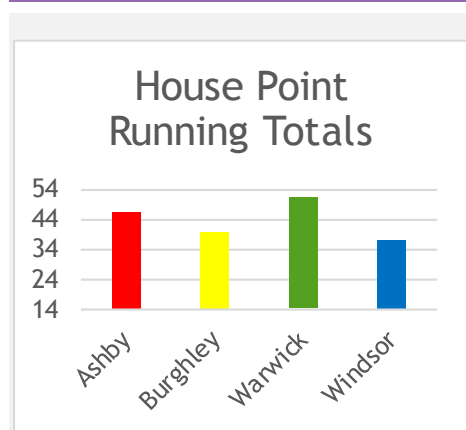
