Dear Parents,

This week we are looking at the rhyme 'Old Macdonald' and we are going to be reading the story of 'The Little Red Hen'. It would be great if the children could bring in any versions of the story that you may have at home, clearly marked with their name on.

We are going to be talking about the working life of the farm and so will be thinking about both the animals and the crops that are grown and harvested. We will be making bread and then in literacy we will be writing a list of the ingredients we needed to make the bread.

We are also going to be talking about Autumn and we are hoping to go on wellie walk around the school grounds and surrounding area. Please bring in wellies tomorrow; we will go out the first afternoon that is fine and send all the Wellie home at the end of the week.

In maths we are focusing on positional language (under, over, next to); this will be in relation to the story of 'Rosie's Walk' by Pat Hutchins.

We will also be sending home homework books on Friday. Homework books will be collected in on a Thursday and then returned to you on a Friday each week (unless otherwise stated). The homework sent home in Reception is meant to be a fun activity for you and your child to do together and will build on the skills that the children are learning in school.
