



**Language, Oracy and Literacy**

This term the children will be building on their knowledge of sentence types and learning how to use questions and exclamations in their writing. They will also be learning to write in the past tense and how to change verbs from present to past tense.

**Mathematics**

This term we will be learning about multiplication and division. We will be grouping objects and dividing them equally to support the learning. This will lead us nicely onto fractions of objects and fractions of amounts.

**Physical and Emotional Health**

This term the children will be learning how to use the wall apparatus in gymnastics. They will also be doing dance inspired fitness sessions to build stamina and co-ordination.

**Tell Me a Story**

**Context:** This term the children will be learning about how to write a traditional tale with an alternative ending. We will begin by looking at the content of a traditional tale and its characters. Then we will be using literature and film to discuss how characters can be portrayed differently.

We will be looking at the village and learning how to draw a map using symbols.
