Hello,

Firstly, I would like to welcome you all to Year 1 - I hope you have all had a restful and enjoyable summer.

This term we will be looking at numbers to 10, number bonds, addition and subtraction and ordinal numbers. In Science we will be learning about animals, including humans and looking at weather and seasonal change, whilst in English we will focus on handwriting improvement and leaving spaces, using full stops, capital letters and adjectives and how phonics knowledge can be applied to help with writing.

In Humanities we will learn about where we are in the world together with the continents and oceans, map reading and the local area.

The class will be doing PE each Tuesday and Forest School each Friday, so may I request that all children have named clothing in school on those days please? The children should also have a school jumper or cardigan in every day as we often go outside for learning and it would be a shame to be restricted in this if there are some children without an extra layer.

We will be listening to the children read individually during the next week and they will be bringing a book home each night to reinforce what they are learning. If you could support this, I would be most grateful. Spellings will usually come home on a Friday evening for testing the following Friday. I will begin this next week.

I'm sure most of you are aware that I taught in Year 1 last year - I'm looking forward to teaching your children and hope to meet you all either at the end of each day or at Parents' Evening later this term.
