In maths Year 1 have been using pictures to write addition calculations.



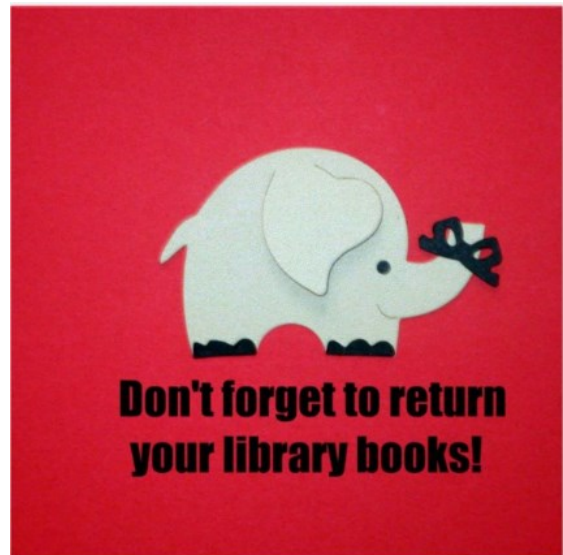
They needed to identify the parts of the picture and the whole.
