

Subject	Unit description
Functional Skills Maths, English, Computing	Students will be working towards the AQA unit award scheme. This includes English, Maths and ICT/computing. They will be working on a variety of tasks to prepare them for future assessments.
AQA Skills for Independent Living Skills for Social Well Being Skills for the Workplace Skills for Leisure	Students will be working towards qualifications covered by the AQA unit award scheme. The qualification will be divided into units covering Communication, Numeracy, ICT, Home Management, Personal Skills and In the Workplace. These units are: Health and safety Basic Skills and food preparation Shopping in a supermarket Road Safety Planning and taking part in a visit
Work Experience	Some students will have local external placements and others in-house placements. They will follow a qualification in Work-right or AQA Health and Safety relating to their place of work.
Science	Students will cover electrical safety, changing materials, being healthy, recycling, health and safety, temperatures and plants/growing throughout the different aspects of the curriculum
Humanities	Students will learn about current affairs and other special days which take place during the Autumn Term: This includes things such as Harvest festival, Hull Fair, Bonfire Night and Halloween.
Drama	Students will take part in lessons which will be led by St. Anne's Drama teacher. During this term the students will be developing the theme for 2017 Rock Challenge and take part in a Christmas service.
Community Practical Maths & English	Students will visit a variety of supermarkets, shopping centres, town centres. The students will locate items, identify different types of shops and ask workers in the shops for assistance when necessary. There will be opportunities to use cafes in the community to experience using money to purchase drinks and snacks.
PSHE	Students will work on the Jigsaw programme, this term they will learn about 'being me in my world' and 'celebrating difference'.
PE	This term the students will cover a range of activities within PE, games and dance.
Expressive Arts	This term the students will start to look at jewellery from different parts of the world including Africa, North America and India. Once they have chosen their favourite, they will produce their own piece of jewellery.
RE	This term the students will learn about different aspects of the topic belonging and believing. They will also do some work about the Christmas story.
