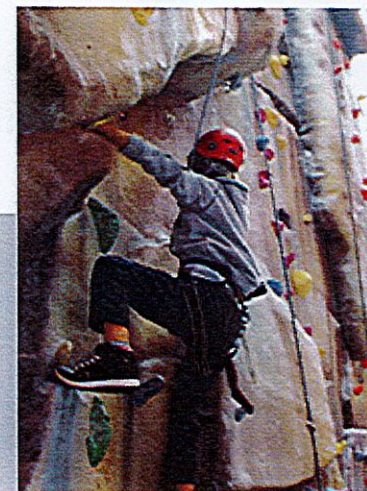


# Short Breaks Family Fun Days
