Poppy Appeal

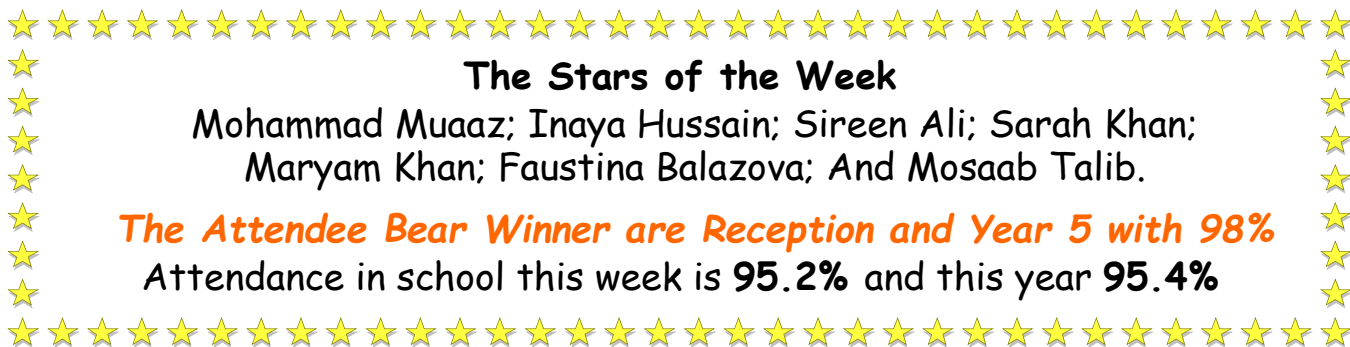
After half term we will be selling poppies and other items on behalf of the Royal British Legion.
