School Crossing Patrol Vacancy

Are you friendly, reliable and willing to work outdoors in all weathers to ensure the safety of children?

Do you care about your community and have a little time to spare? If the answer is yes, you may be interested in becoming a School Crossing Patrol Officer. Patrolling the pedestrian crossing on West Road for Westborough Primary School.

ABOUT THE ROLE

The role of a School Crossing Patrol officer is to ensure the safety of children and parents waiting to cross the road or crossing at a designated point between prescribed times, without detriment to the health and safety of all other road users.

You must be able to work 5 days per week (mornings and afternoons) during school term times. Annual leave only to be taken during School Holidays.

Full training and uniform will be provided.

Main duties and responsibilities:

- To ensure the safety of children crossing the road at a designated point on their journey to and from school.
- To operate hazard warning signs as appropriate.
- To control and direct traffic as appropriate.
- To maintain control over children who are awaiting instructions to cross.
- To use all uniform and equipment provided for personal safety and for the safety of children and other road users, especially when stopping traffic on the Highway.
- To regularly assess the risks associated with operating at the crossing site in order to identify any problems.
- · Report problems and defects to manger
