Maths homework:

We have been learning how to add and subtract ones. The homework this week will be practising this. Please see me to discuss the sheet and method we use in class if it is unclear. The sheet will have been stuck in your child's homework book or sent home (please put into your child's homework book).

The homework and spellings will be given out on a Thursday for the following **Wednesday**. Please note the spelling test will now be on a Wednesday.

Spellings:

Grasshoppers: Focus - the 'n' sound spelt kn or gn. Please try all 12. If you are finding them really hard then try to set yourself a challenge to see how many of them you can learn really well.

knee, knot, kneel, know, knight, knife, knock, knead, knit, gnaw, knuckle, gnome

Owls: If you are confident with your spellings, please see how many of the other spellings you can learn - challenge yourself!

met, set, fan, fun, fat, lip, log, let, had, hit, hen, ship, shop, fish
