Employ a speech and language therapist for ½ a day a week.	£4,500	Improve the provision for the development of early speech and language. Train staff to deliver high quality speech and language activities, provide a language rich environment and to deliver high quality interventions to accelerate progress.
Talk boost training.	£1,000	To train support staff in a proven, quality intervention to enhance speech and vocabulary.
TA to deliver Positive Play 4 x ½ days a week.	£8,000	Individuals emotionally supported so that they are able to access the classroom and learn. To increase self-confidence in children with social and emotional issues and those who have experienced trauma. To foster self-esteem and enable the children to access the learning in the classroom through the setting of personal targets and all staff working together around the child.
Specialist TA to deliver Nurture groups and provide behaviour support on a small group or individual basis. 3 x afternoons a week.	£7,000	Personalised interventions and support to support children so that they can engage in the wider curriculum. To increase confidence and self-esteem which will enable the children to learn more effectively in the classroom.

Family Support Worker – 5 mornings a week	£12,500	Families signposted to wider services and support (ie Family Centre). Behaviour support facilitated for target group of parents and children. Attendance monitored daily and followed up with a robust system.
Appointment of specialist ECaR Teacher	£23,000	<p>Significant daily intervention programme to improve pupil attainment and progress in early reading so that the children are able to apply skills across the wider curriculum.</p> <p>To increase parental involvement for all target pupils. To train reading volunteers to be used across school to improve frequency of reading for target pupils.</p> <p>To train staff in delivering quality reading interventions.</p> <p>To deliver the inference intervention to target pupils.</p> <p>To boost KS2 pupils in reading through personalised targeted 1:1 support.</p>
