Can you test a range of materials to find out which is the best for a superhero costume? Think about what properties the materials have and why they would make a good costume.</p>	<p>Research a real-life hero that you admire. Could you create a piece of artwork based on how they were or are heroic during their life? For example, this could be a painting, drawing or model!</p>	<p>Superheroes need to keep fit! Can you create a keep-fit dance with four repeated movements for us all to follow?</p>	<p>Think of your favourite superhero. Can you create a theme song for them? Perhaps you could perform this with some of your friends!</p>	<p>Talk to a member of your family about a hero that they admire. Could you write some questions for them to answer? Come and tell us about what they shared!</p>

In addition to the daily reading and key words practise set by the class teacher, these extra challenges link to topics which are taught this term and encourage children to use a broad range of skills. All children should complete at least one challenge over the term. They can do more than one challenge if they choose.
