Who can sprint the quickest?</p>	<p>Can you create a theme tune for your superhero? What background music might suit your character's personality?</p>	<p>We will be learning about real life superheroes this term. Can you create a fact file about a famous real life superhero such as Florence Nightingale? Ask a family member to work with you to create this fact file.</p>
