## Our performance successes during 2017-18

### EYFS

In July 2018 64% of children were working at a Good Level of Development. The National average was 71%. This is the first year we have sat below the national average and is reflective of the cohorts needs.

### Year 1 Phonics Test

The Year 1 phonics test produced outstanding results with 96% of our pupils achieving the required level. This is 15% higher than the national average of 81%.

### Year 2 Standardised Tests

Our results in the Standardised Tests for Year 2 once more indicate that our high standards have been maintained with our pupils achieving significantly above the national average in reading, writing and maths. 100% achieving ARE+ in Reading, 100% in Writing and 97% in Maths. 45% of our pupils achieved Greater Depth in Reading, 34% in Writing and 45% in Maths. Progress rates across KS1 were also very high with children making 6.7 points avg points progress in Reading, Writing and Maths (avg is 6 points).

### KS2

Our results in the Teacher assessments for Years 3 & 4 continue to demonstrate that children are making excellent attainment and progress throughout the school in all areas of learning. 97% achieving ARE+ in Reading, 87% in Writing and 87% in Maths. 48% of our pupils achieved Greater Depth in Reading, 29% in Writing and 39% in Maths. Progress rates across KS2 were also very good with children making an astonishing 7.4 points avg points progress in Reading, 6.4 in Writing and 5.9 in Maths (avg is 6 points).

We remain an Outstanding school from the OfSTED inspections in July 2008. This was further endorsed by our interim inspection of January 2011 that claimed our outstanding performance has been sustained and held.

We also remain an Outstanding Church school following our SIAMS inspection in 2018.

We also undertook a Mocksted in March 2014 from an Ofsted Inspector and were awarded Outstanding.
