## Science

This term, we will carry out a plant investigation about what plants need to grow and record our data using IT. We will then be exploring rocks where we will compare and group rocks according to their properties, describe how fossils are formed and recognise that soils are made from rocks.

## Thematic Curriculum (History, Geography, DT)

Our topic is Rebellious Romans where we will explore the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. This will include; Julius Caesar's invasion, the Roman Empire by 42AD and the power of its army, Claudius invasion and conquest, British resistance (Boudica) and Romanisation of British sites.

## Health and Well-being (Art, Music, Sport)

In art, we will be learning to tell stories through the images we create. We will be looking at images of Roman sculptures to inspire their own sketches.

In music we will venture into composing and improvising. These skills will add depth to the songs that we will learn to sing and play on tuned percussion. Starting to read staff notation will be our newest challenge!
