Use a supermarket website to add these items to your basket and find the total cost. What is the difference compared to your average weekly shop now?</p> | <p>Design and build your own air raid shelter, using recycled materials.</p>      | <p>Act out the Christmas truce with your friends on the playground – half of you will need to play German and half of you will need to play English soldiers. End it with a friendly game of football!</p> | <p>Research war time music on Youtube. Find your favourite to recommend to the class – we will listen to your recommendations together.</p> <p>Write the lyrics to a song that you would have produce if you were in the war. Think about what message you would want to give people after listening to your track.</p> | <p>Interview a member of your community that had family involved in WW2 or any other war. Make notes about how they felt and what they encountered.</p> |

All children should complete at least one challenge over the term, but can do more than one challenge if they choose. Children will be awarded a raffle ticket for each challenge completed, which will be entered into a prize draw at the end of the term! The children will also receive SPAG and maths tasks each week. Maths tasks will be set on Mathletics on a **Friday** and will be due the following Friday. Spellings will be sent home on a Tuesday to be tested the following **Tuesday**. A raffle ticket will also be rewarded for each completed task - the more home learning completed, the better the chance of winning! Every child is expected to read at home daily and get at least three signatures in their reading record to show this. We are encouraging children to change their books independently at school.
