On Wednesday, Parrots Class went to the Thinktank museum in Birmingham to see an electricity show. We discovered about scientists from over the years and even made a working human circuit. WW2 Enrichment Day



On the 25th of October 2018, Simon Hannaford came in to talk to us about his job in the army, which is dismantling and disarming bombs.



As part of our WW2 topic, told us about what munitions (different types of weapons) were used during that time, and to show us what bombs look like so we don't touch them. To be a well trained bomb disposal expert, you need to train for 12 years. Interestingly, not all soldiers can become bomb disposal experts – you have to be a certain rank to do it. We looked at 4 different types of bombs, and got to touch some of them as well. It was really interesting.

The Kinder Children of Upton House

In the afternoon, Jane – who works at Upton House, came in to talk to us about Kinder transport – which was an evacuee scheme for German children to come to England in 1938 (just before the war started). We learnt the story of Max Nawratski, who had a twin sister called Ruth. He made it to England, but his sister didn't. He never found out what happened to his mum, sister and dad, who were left in Germany – even after the war was over. We saw some old photos that belonged to Max, old coins which were in use in the 1940s, which had strange names like farthing, thruppence and ha'penny and a story folder of Max's life. It was a really fun day. Thank you to the adults who came in to talk to us. We learnt so much!
