

Science

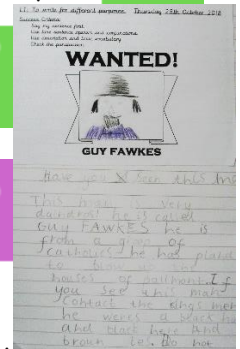

This week we have written poems which are "recipes" for being a good firefighter. The children did such a great job that we wrote them up for display - coming to a classroom window near you soon!

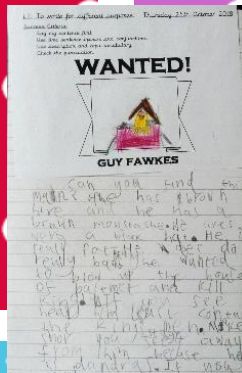
We also wrote WANTED posters for Guy Fawkes. We used descriptive and topic vocabulary.
