**Spellings:**

I would like everyone to practice the spellings and spelling rules we have learnt this term. Choose some words from each week to practice, remember to practice writing them too!

**Grasshoppers:**

**or** sounds spelt **a** before **l** or **ll**. all, tall, ball, hall, always, altogether, also, small, chalk, walk, talk

soft **c** when **c** comes before **i**, **y** or **e** it usually makes the **s** sound. race, face, certain, price, excellent, except, police, cycle, pencil

Adding the suffix **-y**. funny, saggy, dotty, yummy, foggy, slippy, spotty

Adding the suffix **-y** to some root words ending in **e** to make adjectives. Drop the **e** before adding **y**. breeze – breezy, mousy, simply, greasy, smoky, crazy, spiky, bony, lazy.

Adding the suffix **-ly** to root words to make an adverb. Badly, quickly, kindly, loudly, warmly, snugly, softly, weakly.

**n** sound spelt **kn** or **gn**. knee, knot, know, knight, knife, knock, knit, gnaw, knuckle, gnome

**Owls:** Practice **sit, had, the, and, fish, ship, cat** and any other words you find difficult. Then practice some of the grasshoppers spellings please for each spelling pattern.
