Governor Roles and Responsibilities – September 2018

The governing body holds eight full governing body meetings per year; at least three of which are held during the school day so that they can be combined with monitoring activities within school. All governors attend these meetings. Separate, smaller committee meetings are only held to complete specific tasks as directed by the Full Governing Body. For example the finance governors meet to prepare documentation/papers to be presented to the full governing body (such as the SFVS review and the school budget).

All governors are linked to a class/year group in school and move up with them as they progress through the school. Through this link governors are involved in monitoring the curriculum and provision, reviewing attainment and progress and develop an understanding of teaching and learning for their year group.
