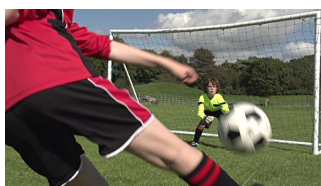

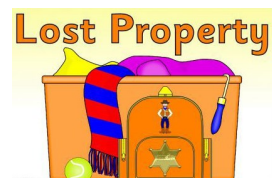


All of our pupils who have celebrated their birthdays this week.
