We invite your students to join us for a free 2-hour taster session, to try their hand at guitar, drums, singing or at 'The Rock Project'.
Of the 80 schools, we run locally out of Hadleigh Junior School: on Saturdays between 9am and 1.15pm.

Our students are tutored by professional musicians *all tutors hold enhanced DBS certificates.

The emphasis is firmly on education and the enjoyment thereof, but there are a few added transferable benefits to learning music:

Mental skills: Studies document that students who learn music tend to do better in other subjects including maths, science and learning a foreign language.

Perseverance: Learning to play an instrument fosters focus and determination.

Creativity: Having learning some basics, comes the opportunity for getting creative with music. This is a great form of self-expression.

Control: Creating notes from an instrument helps fine-tune motor skills. Small movements of the hands and fingers help create neurological pathways in the brain enhancing motor skills.

Self-confidence: At The Rock Project, students play in front of their tutors, then other students, in a band, and finally on stage before a large audience. Each step is designed to build self-confidence, gradually but noticeably.

Social skills: As well as making new friends with a common interest, at The Rock Project we play as a band, which helps to develop team-working skills.

We have left flyers in reception for book bags and have emailed the office with an electronic flyer for inclusion in the newsletter or for the noticeboard.
