Just a quick reminder that we will be having our Halloween disco this Friday (2nd November). Tickets are available via ParentMail. I look forward to seeing you all in your costumes!

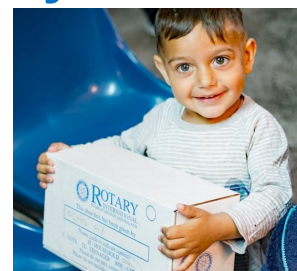


## Playground Development
