The Daily Mile



You may have heard about 'The Daily Mile' on the news. It is a nationwide initiative to get more activity into children's lives. It obviously helps children stay physically fit but has also been shown to help their mental health too.

If you dropped your children off at the Chestnut Avenue site this morning you will have seen that we have had white lines painted on the playground to create two lanes that go around the perimeter, one for walking and one for running - 10 laps = 1 mile.

We are encouraging children to come into school and walk or run around the track until the bell goes. For each lap that they complete they will receive a token. These tokens will be collected and placed in the clear plastic box for their class.

At the end of each half term the class with the most tokens will go on a trip to do something active such as visiting a climbing wall or trampoline park.

How can you help?

We would love you to join your child by walking (or running) around the track with them.

If you don't feel ready to do that we really need the children to be in the playground before the gates shut so they can participate, so please make sure they are in school every day and on time.
