Create something using Scratch.

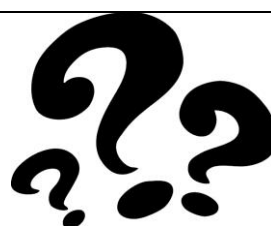


Have a look at this website and have a go at a maths problem on it and show us your findings.
