Staff Car-Park

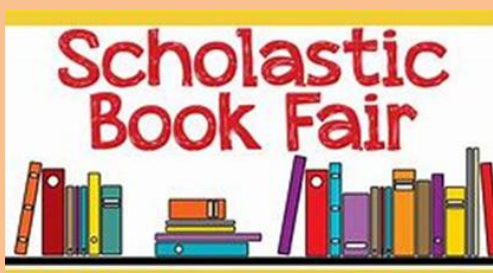
