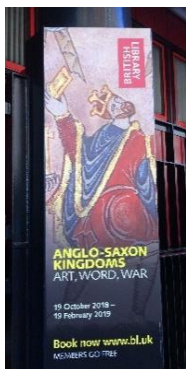
Remembrance Events
