Warm Clothing

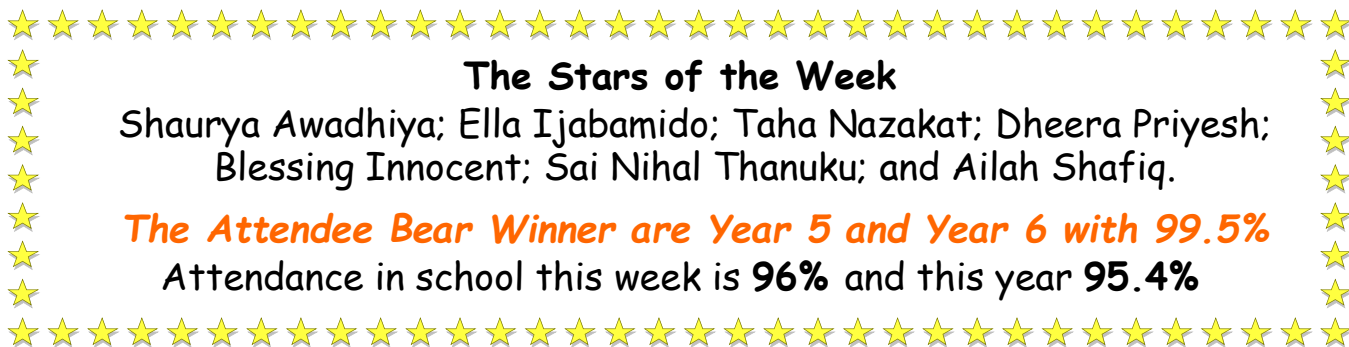
