Dear Parents/Carers,

We will be starting our showcase from 2:45. We would love for as many of you to come as possible, however we do understand it can be difficult for some. Any questions do not hesitate to ask.



Things to remember:

- ❖ Your child will have PE on Monday and Friday and therefore she/he will need PE kit for both sessions. I am more than happy for children to wear joggers, coats and other winter clothing as we are approaching the colder months. As a school, we had a handful of children with PE kit consistently missing or pieces of clothing missing last year. Please ensure this is no longer an issue as they do not get to take part in the lessons fully. If a child is to be excused from PE lessons we do require a doctor's note for this.
- ❖ Please remember that we are now a paperless school wherein letters are emailed, thus it is vital you check your emails on a regular basis. For those who have not provided an email address, we will provide paper copies of the appropriate letters. As ever, copies of any mislaid letters can be obtained from the office.
- ❖ The weather is reaching the colder months, so please ensure your child has their jumper or cardigan and a coat with them.
- ❖ If you have a chance, we would love you to come in and read with the class or another class from 9am to 9:20am on Fridays.
- ❖ Children are expected to read on a regular basis and bring in their reading diaries every Monday to be checked and signed. Our reading focus this half term will be retrieving and recording facts from a given piece of text.



❖ **Homework reminder:**

- Children are asked to read every evening (Monday-Friday).
- In KS2 we encourage children to record their reading in their Reading Records. These will be checked regularly.
- Mental magicians/spellings will be tested every week.
- Children will also be given Maths and English homework once a week, which again will be checked and recorded. If children fail to bring in their homework when it is due on a Tuesday, they will be expected to attend homework club to make up for this.
- However, a child can attend homework club of their own accord to complete homework or their take home task.
- Children will be given a set of ten spellings which they are expected to learn and will be tested on these on a two weekly cycle.
- Year 5 will not be set a take home task during this half term as we have a project going on in school with our log books, which we will be sharing with you during our parent showcase.

As always if there are any worries or concerns, or you just want to check how your child is getting on, please don't hesitate to catch me before or after school.
