Dear Parents and Carers,

We have organised an exciting 'Hook Day' on Tuesday 6th November to introduce our new topic of World War Two for next term's theme, 'Thank You'. The children will experience a day in the life of an evacuee, engaging in many different activities lead by Mr Yates, Mrs Myers and Miss Abel. These will include role-play activities, cooking with rations, letter writing and singing wartime songs. The day will culminate in a play performed by the children which you are invited to attend at 2.30pm in the hall.

In order to make this experience as realistic as possible, the Year 3/4 Team will be dressing up in 1940s style clothes and ask that your child also comes in costume, as an evacuee. This can be very simply plain coloured clothes and could include knee length shorts or a skirt, long socks and a blouse/shirt with a cardigan, jumper or tank top.

To re-enact the emotional goodbye of an evacuee we also request, where possible, that you bring your child to school at 08:40 and remain on the playground until approximately 09:00 when the 'evacuees' will be sent off on their 'train ride to the countryside!'

We are looking forward to the day and hope your children enjoy the immersive experience.
