

TAKE HOME TASK

You have a choice of two different activities for your take home task this half term.

Option One

Create a gadget for a spy. Use your imagination and creativity. You may decide you would like to design the gadget or even make it. It could be a prototype or an actual working gadget!

Option Two

Create your own spy (or detective). You could create an illustration of this character, write a story about them or even make a costume and dress up as them - either to be photographed or starring in your own mini movie!

As always, what you do and how you present your task is up to you. I am always thrilled with the creative interpretations of the take home tasks and as a class we thoroughly enjoy sharing them! Please remember, you are Year 6 and you are being given over four weeks to complete this task and therefore the quality of your product should reflect this.

Below are some optional tasks you may also want to do.

Research different spies in history and write a report on them. It could be a real spy or a spy from fiction. You could present your report on paper or using the technology of your choice.

Find out about different prisons in the world - for example Alcatraz - and report this information in the way of your choosing. Make sure you locate them on a map. Could you also create blueprints of the prison?

Read a book, watch a film or television programme about spies or detectives and write a review about it.

The James Bond theme is very iconic. Create your own theme tune for a spy. This could be done using musical instruments or an app.

Your take home task is due in on **Friday 14th December**. You may begin bringing in the tasks from the beginning of the week.
