This half term our topic is

Space



Why 'Space' ?

Space is at the forefront of all technology and with our every changing planet it is important our children know about Earth and the rest of the solar system.

As readers and writers we will be...

Creating our own newspaper reports following an alien invasion at Henda Primary School. Alongside, creating some inspiring travel brochures for some undiscovered planets!

As mathematicians we will be...

using formal written methods to solve multiplication and division problems. We will be investigating perimeter and area of shapes. We will be reading and interpreting information presented in graphs and tables to solve problems.

As scientists we will be...

Exploring our solar system. The children will be investigating and categorising the planets within our solar system as well as looking at how the planets rotate and orbit.

To develop our understanding of religion we will be...

*Continuing our investigations into:
'Why do some people believe God exists?'*

To bring our topic to life we will be...

Engaging in hands on learning both inside and outside of the classroom. The children will become the planets to develop their understanding of how the solar system is arranged.

As explorers we will be...

Researching key elements of Space. Including Britain's famous astronaut—Tim Peake, the International Space Station and question whether they think there is life on another planet.
