

Term 2 Plan for Year Six - November 2018

Maths

- Solve problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- Use common factors to simplify fractions; use common multiples to express fractions in the same denomination.
- Compare and order fractions, including fractions > 1
- Add and subtract fractions with different denominators and mixed numbers, using the concept of equivalent fractions.
- Multiply simple pairs of proper fractions, writing the answer in its simplest form.

- Children will learn about great artists in history including Paul Cezanne and Carl Warner.

- Using a wide range of devices to build cohesion within and across paragraphs.

Science

Children will learn to:

- Describe how living things (including animals, plants and micro-organisms) are classified into broad groups according to observable characteristics.
- Plan different types of scientific enquiries to answer questions and recognise and control variables.
