Year Group: Two. Topic: Healthy Party Planners

English

- We follow the Success For All program in English. (SFA)
- Real books are used with reading and writing based around each book. Spellings and vocabulary are covered within the SFA lesson.
- Handwriting lessons take place twice weekly to teach the joins and to practice a joined, cursive style of handwriting.
- Spellings are taught in a separate lesson.

Science

- Little Masterchefs - Our science learning will be based on what humans need to do to stay healthy, including exercise, food, water and hygiene.
- We will also learn about changing the shape of materials.

History, Geography, Art, Music D&T and ICT

- Our topic of Healthy Party Planners inspires the learning in these subjects. In Geography we will be learning about where food comes from and drawing plans of familiar places. We will learn the names of the capital cities and continents of the world.
- Art & Design Technology: Fruit printing; food faces in the style of Giuseppe Arcimboldo; observational drawing; making party placemats; design healthy party food, decorations and hats.
- In ICT we will build our skills by using a computer to collect data and make simple databases and record music and our food face pictures in photographs on iPads.
- In Music we will learn songs for our Christmas performance and play along using percussion instruments.

Mathematics

- This half term we will be developing skills in multiplication and division, and learning to count in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- We will be learning about how to estimate, compare and measure lengths; choosing and using standard units m, cm, kg
- We will begin to use our learning to solve word problems involving multiplication, division and length.

PSHE and RE

- In RE we will be covering the Christmas story through our performance.
