Our Christmas post box will be ready for action on December 3rd. If your child would like to send cards to their friends please make sure they are clearly labelled with the child's name and key group. Class group lists will be available from your child's key person.

Safe Guarding

Please make sure you close all gates and doors behind you when entering/exiting the building.

For the safety of all children please **do not park on the zig-zag lines outside the school gates** or in front of the school gates. **This is a danger to other road users and to the children in Nursery.**

Preparing for WINTER

Please make sure your child has a warm coat for school. Children will be playing outdoors every day. Help your child by putting their **name** clearly on their coat.



Hats, scarves and gloves will also need to be labelled.

Please check that your child has picked up the correct school jumper and return clothes which do not belong to your child.

During severe weather conditions we may have to close the school if there are transport and safety issues. Please ensure that we have the correct mobile number for you to receive text updates. Also listen out for announcements on the local radio before setting off to school. Free Radio, Heart FM or Radio WM.
