- Fine motor - threading and sewing

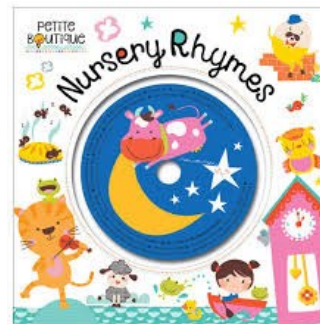
Personal, Social and Emotional Development
