Subject	Curriculum
Religion	In Religion we follow ' The Way, The Truth and The Life Scheme of Work '. We cover six topics during the year: Autumn Term: Called To Serve & Justice Spring Term: Exploring the Mass & Jesus the Messiah Summer Term: The Kingdom of God & Faith in Action
English	In English we follow the National Curriculum . Within each half term, children in Year 6 explore writing for a range of audiences and purposes. These purposes include: writing to entertain, writing to persuade, writing to discuss and writing to inform. We use a variety of rich texts as a stimulus for writing, to gain inspirations and as a model to aspire towards. We use Read, Write, Inc scheme for spelling. Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar objectives .
Maths	We follow the Year 6 National Curriculum with support from White Rose Maths Hub planning
Science	In Science we cover five topics each year. In Year 6 we follow the National Curriculum over three terms Autumn - Living things & Animals including humans Spring - Electricity Summer - Light & Evolution and inheritance
I.C.T.	In Computing we follow the National Curriculum .
French	In French we follow the National Curriculum and use the i-languages scheme .
PE	In P.E. we do Gymnastics, Dance, Ball games and Athletics and follow the National Curriculum . We also follow Real PE to develop key skills. Year 6 also go on a Residential trip doing adventurous activities.
Music	We follow the National Curriculum . We use the Charanga music platform and take part in weekly singing practice occurs.
Citizenship	We study Global Communities, Drugs, Transition and Puberty Education . We also study British Values and Journey in Love .
