



### Use of Sports Premium April 2017-18

Funding for this year is **£10,588**. We will receive a similar amount for the academic year 2018 - 2019 although this may fluctuate slightly due to numbers on roll. Projected costings may vary due to the availability of coaches and changing needs of certain year groups.

The school is committed to providing swimming lessons to year 3,4 & 5 at a cost of £4250. The percentage of children achieving National Curriculum levels is 2017-18
