**SUN PROTECTION POLICY**

At Aston All Saints Church of England Primary School we want staff and pupils to enjoy the sun safely. We will work with everyone in our school community to achieve this through –

**EDUCATION**

- Children will be encouraged to be safe in the sun through PSHE lessons, circle time/discussions and at break times and lunch times by the staff on duty
- Posters and advice will be displayed in school for pupils, parents and staff

**PROTECTION**

- SHADE
  - There are a number of mature trees which provide shade for both Foundation, infant and junior children
  - The planting of new trees is always under review
  - Children are actively involved in the planting of new trees and are encouraged to understand why and where they are placed
  - There are sheltered seating areas for both infant and junior children
- CLOTHING
  - Children should bring hats to school in the warm and sunny weather and are always encouraged by staff to wear them
  - Children in the F2 class who access the outdoors as part of their curriculum will not be allowed outdoors without hats when the weather is warm and sunny.
  - School uniform – whether polo shirts or summer dresses for the girls all have sleeves which covers shoulders in warm and sunny weather
- SUNSCREEN
  - Children are allowed, with their parents' permission, to bring sunscreen to school. It is the parents' responsibility to send sunscreen into school.
  - School policy is that children will apply their own sunscreen and will not share their sunscreen with anyone else
