Attendance update – reporting an absence

We are trialling a new system in our school offices. Once you have reported an absence you will receive a text message later in the morning to confirm this. You don't need to do anything when you receive this message. It is for safeguarding purposes to confirm with parents that your child is not in school.

Authorised or Unauthorised?

Generally, we will only authorise a child's illness for a maximum of 3 days unless medical evidence is shown to the school office. Some absences for illness may not be authorised at all if we feel that the child should be in school, for example, if they have a sore throat, headache or a cold.

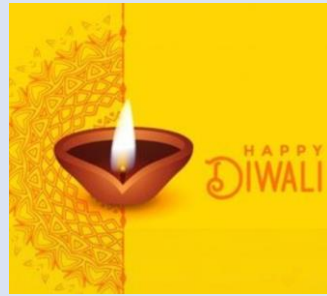
