Weekly Homework tasks

We expect the following tasks to be completed weekly by all children:

- Learn the sounds of the week/ Phonics task
- Reading (at least 3 times per week, signed in their reading record by an adult)
- Choose a Math challenge to complete from the pack

Your child will receive Dojo points for homework tasks completed. They will also achieve merit awards in assembly for reading, progress in Rockstar maths and exceptional homework.
